About Marianne North

- Marianne North was born in 1830, at a time when hardly anyone was able to travel outside of their country.
- It was even more unusual for women to travel than men. Women were expected to stay at home and raise a family
- Marianne North travelled the world painting plants, people and places. She was a **botanist** as well as an artist and explorer.
- In 14 years she visited 15 countries, painting the people, places and plants that she saw. Brazil, Jamaica, Japan and India were among the countries she visited.

Marianne painted the exotic places and plants she saw on her travels. You can see her paintings at Xew Gardens in Rondon
