I can find a number on a number line

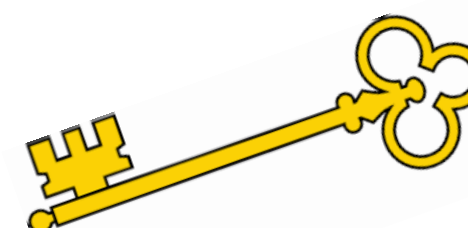
I can compare groups by matching
