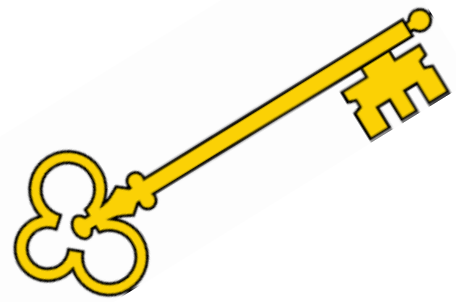

- There are 100 pennies in a pound.
- We have coins for 1 pence, 2 pence, 5 pence, 10 pence, 20 pence, 50 pence, 1 pound and 2 pounds.
- The pounds symbol looks like this £
- We have notes for £5, £10, £20 and £50.
- When we pay too much money for something because the notes or coins are too big for what we owe, we are given change.
