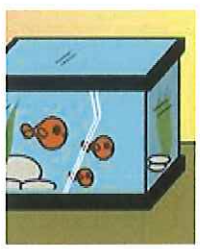


**School Council Report**

tank.



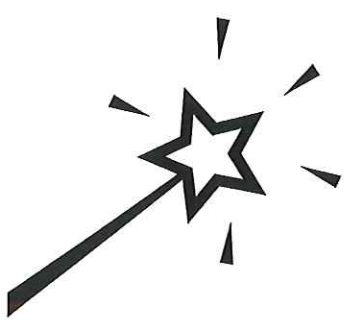
We paid the
