Treasure Island

Write a review of Treasure Island.

You might want to use the template on the website under Literacy Planning 01.06.20 or you could create your own.

Answer the following questions...

- What was your favourite part of the story and why?
- Who was your favourite character and why?
- If you could change one part of the story what would it be?
- How do you think Jim changed during the story? What was he like at the beginning and what was he like at the end?

Give Treasure Island a rating out of five and create your own review caption.

e.g. 'Gripping drama, held me on the edge of my seat, full of exciting cliff hangers'

The template is titled 'Treasure Island by Robert Louis Stevenson' and features two pirate icons. It contains five sections for student responses:

- A large box for drawing a picture of a favourite part of the story, with a prompt to explain why it is a favourite part.
- A box for identifying the favourite character and explaining why.
- Two side-by-side boxes for suggesting changes to the story and for reflecting on how the character Jim changed.
- A box at the bottom for giving the book a rating out of five and writing a review caption.
