In this episode we hear Silver using some very strange turns of phrase – talking in an unusual 'pirate' way. Some examples are:

'Before an hour's out, I'll stove in your old block house like a rum puncheon. Laugh, by thunder. Laugh! Before an hour's out, ye'll laugh upon the other side.

OR

Them that die'll be the lucky ones.

Talk with someone at home about what these phrases might mean.

e.g. Before the hour's out, we'll be a feasting on the gifts of the cold store.
