### Today's Literacy Activity

#### **Planning for Non-Chronological Report**

We have followed the story of Treasure Island over a number of weeks now and spent some time learning about Pirates.

I would now like you to pull together everything you have learnt about Pirates into one Non-Chronological Report.

Today, I would like you to have a look at the Non-Chronological Report steps to success and then use the planning template to plan your own non-chronological report about Pirates.

There are also a few examples of non-chronological reports to look at to give you ideas on text type features and how they can be laid out on the page.

Remember though... Treasure Island was a fictional story. The events are not historical events but you might have picked up information about pirates from the story, for example the idea of being marooned, mutiny and the black spot.
