

This week at Little Learners:

We have been talking about football.

We dressed up in our football kits to wear to school. We talked about the teams we support and the colour of the kits.

We created a football collage; cutting out pictures of football resources and using glue to stick them to make a picture.

We made flags and medals. Some of us used red tissue paper to make an England flag and talked about watching England play football on the TV.

We waved our flags and pretended we were watching football and wore our medals pretending we were winners!

We looked at lots of football cards with pictures of different players who will be playing in the Euros. We tried to guess which team they played for and matched the flag on the card with our flags hanging up in the garden.

In the garden we played lots of football! We practised our dribbling skills, controlling the ball around tyres and took turns to try to score a penalty.

We did a size ordering activity using pictures of different football resources. We had to find big, biggest, medium, small and smallest.

We continued with our daily phonics, learning to link letters with sounds (phonemes). We incorporated some football words into our phonics such as goal, boots, football, player and trophy.

As it was hot this week, we enjoyed lots of sand and water play in the garden, pretending we were at the beach!

Now the weather has turned warmer, a reminder that sun cream should be applied to your child before they come to school and they require a hat for outside play. Please also provide a named water bottle.
