

This week at Little Learners:

We have been learning about transport.

We made paper planes and flew them out in the garden. We measured how far they flew.

We made traffic light signs and used them to role play in the garden. We talked about what red, amber and green mean on a traffic light. We rode up and down in our vehicles and took turns to 'stop' the traffic.

We created a road and made some roundabouts. We used the road in small world play and pushed our cars up and down the road.

We used chalk to create a 'town' on the table; we drew roads, houses, shops, a school and garage.

At end circle we talked about different types of transport and where we might use them.

We used transport picture cards during phonics to learn the initial sound (phoneme) in each word.

We also used vehicle pictures for counting, matching and size ordering. We learnt some new words such as 'tram' and 'airship.'

We used a big empty box to create a boat using long bricks as oars. Then we added chairs to make it a bigger boat so our friends could play too.

We used cars to mark make in flour, pushing the cars around to make tracks.
