This week at Little Learners:

We have been talking about starting school in September. We talked about the uniform we will wear and about the new friends we will make.

We designed a school uniform; we drew pictures of what we would like our uniform to look like.

We practised lots of things to help us get ready for school such as putting on our coat and shoes independently and writing our name.
