This week at Little Learners:

We have been doing activities about friendship, sharing and using our manners.

We played table top games where we had to listen to instructions, share and take turns. Our favourite games were 'Hungry hippos' and 'Magnetic fishing.'

We played a shopping list game where we had to find the items on our list. Then we got paper, pens and clipboards and asked everybody in pre-school what they wanted to add to the list.

We created kindness hearts by cutting out a heart shape and decorating it. We then talked about how we could be kind to others and wrote it on our heart. We attached ribbon so we could hang them up.
