## Vocabulary

- ₱─ Blues-a style- a style of music characterised by its harmonic structure.
- ► Baroque period of music from 1600-1750AD
- ► Latin Fusion music from South America. Full of catchy rhythms.
- ► Irish Folk- music sung and played by people, often not recorded
- ► Funk-music with strong bass lines
- → Pulse- the regular heartbeat of the music
- ► Rhythm- long and short sounds that happen over the pulse
- → Pitch-high and low sounds
- ► Compose- create and develop music
- → Improvise-to make up a tune and play it on the spot
- → Perform singing and playing for others to hear
- → Groove-the rhythmic part of music that makes you want to move and dance
- ► Keyboard- electric instrument played like a piano
- ► Bass Lowest part of the music
