In a Tirio village deep in the heart of the Amazon rain forest, the shaman Nahtahlah has a place of honour in his tribe. Young Kamanya wants to learn the healing secrets of the forest plants--he hopes that he, too, will become the tribe's shaman, so that he can cure his people.

This story teaches us about the lives of tribal people in the Amazon and how their lives are affected by visitors to their lands. We also read the children The Vanishing Rainforest by Lynne Cherry, which also studies the effect of deforestation and habitat loss on the tribespeople of the Amazon.
