Play 'Just a Minute' Set a one minute timer and give each other one minute to speak on a subject without stopping!	Write a letter to yourself in the future.	Ask a grown up to teach you the words to their favourite song.	Make a wordsearch containing 10 words linked to your topic.
Write a letter or postcard to somebody special who you haven't been able to see for a while.	Write a silly sentence about your family.	Play the countdown letters game. Pick 9 letters and see how many words you can make in a set amount of time.	Play 'I spy' / Scrabble or 'Hang man'
Learn the Makaton or British Sign Language signs for 'Thank you', 'Miss you' 'Love you'	Write a letter to someone you admire, or write to someone about a cause you strongly believe in.	Read a book that you haven't read before. If you like it, why not write a quick book review so your friends know how good it is?	Choose a word like 'ear' make new words by adding letters on the end like earwig, earworm, earring. Pick a different part of the body i.e. hand and repeat – handbag.
Word chain game – First player starts by saying a word, the next player has to say another word that links to that in some way i.e. cold – freezing – shiver. If you pause for more than 3 seconds or give an incorrect word then you are out.	Write an alternative fairy tale. Maybe include characters from one fairy and put them into a different story. E.g. Little Red Riding Hood goes to the Three Bears' house.	How many words can you make from the letters in LOCKDOWN? How many words can you make from the letters in LEEDON LOWER SCHOOL	Make a story – someone begins by saying the first sentence of the story, then another person makes up the next sentence of the story and so on.
