<p>Play 'Just a Minute'</p> <p>Set a one minute timer and give each other one minute to speak on a subject without stopping!</p>	<p>Write a letter to yourself in the future.</p>	<p>Ask a grown up to teach you the words to their favourite song.</p>	<p>Make a wordsearch containing 10 words linked to your topic.</p>
<p>Write a letter or postcard to somebody special who you haven't been able to see for a while.</p>	<p>Write a silly sentence about your family.</p>	<p>Play the countdown letters game.</p> <p>Pick 9 letters and see how many words you can make in a set amount of time.</p>	<p>Play 'I spy' / Scrabble or 'Hang man'</p>
<p>Learn the Makaton or British Sign Language signs for 'Thank you', 'Miss you' 'Love you'</p>	<p>Write a letter to someone you admire, or write to someone about a cause you strongly believe in.</p>	<p>Read a book that you haven't read before. If you like it, why not write a quick book review so your friends know how good it is?</p>	<p>Choose a word like 'ear'... make new words by adding letters on the end like earwig, earworm, earring. Pick a different part of the body i.e. hand and repeat – handbag.</p>
<p>Word chain game – First player starts by saying a word, the next player has to say another word that links to that in some way i.e. cold – freezing – shiver. If you pause for more than 3 seconds or give an incorrect word then you are out.</p>	<p>Write an alternative fairy tale. Maybe include characters from one fairy and put them into a different story. E.g. Little Red Riding Hood goes to the Three Bears' house.</p>	<p>How many words can you make from the letters in LOCKDOWN?</p> <p>How many words can you make from the letters in</p> <p>LEEDON LOWER SCHOOL</p>	<p>Make a story – someone begins by saying the first sentence of the story, then another person makes up the next sentence of the story and so on.</p>
