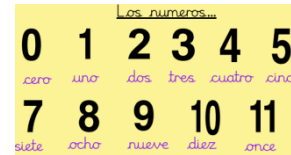

- The **determiner** “The” in Spanish can be “el” or “la” if it’s in singular or “los” or “las” if it’s in plural. They normally end with the same letter as the noun.
