Grammar

- In Spanish, **masculine** nouns often end in –o and **feminine** words often end in –a.
- How many?
Interrogative - cuántos, cuántas
- The **determiner** “The” in Spanish can be “el” or “la” if it’s in singular or “los” or “las” if it’s in plural. They normally end with the same letter as the noun.
