Captain James Cook

Who Was James Cook?

James Cook was born in Middlesbrough, England, in 1728. He died in 1779.



How did he start?

He started to sail aged 18 and after a few years, he joined the Navy.

Where did he travel?

James Cook was the captain of a ship that went to **Australia** and **New Zealand.** He sailed in **Antarctica** and went to **Hawaii**. He met the people who lived there and told them that the King of England now owned their land.

What happened to him?

In 1779, Captain Cook landed on Hawaii and was killed when he tried to kidnap the King of Hawaii.
