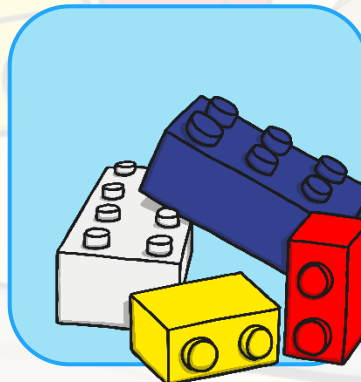
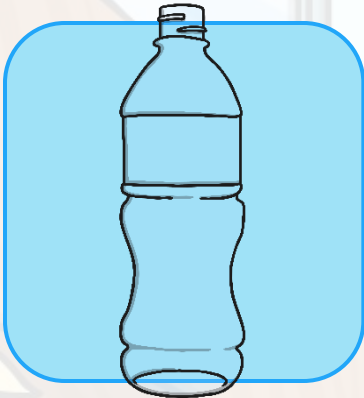
These objects are all made from wood!

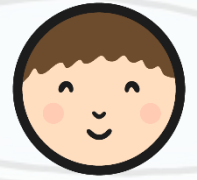
