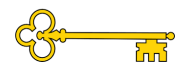

Where will the hour hand be at half past ___?

Sort the activities into **before** and **after** school.



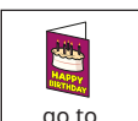

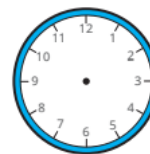


eight o'clock

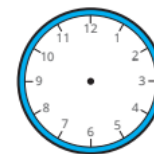


1 o'clock

I can name and order the days of the week

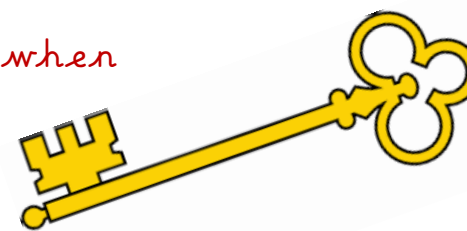
I can name and order the months of the year
