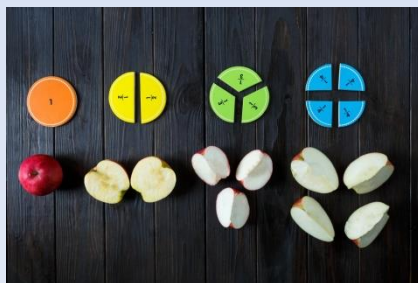

A third

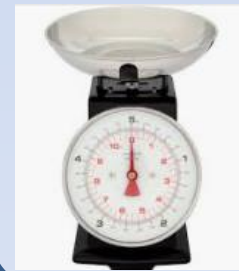
