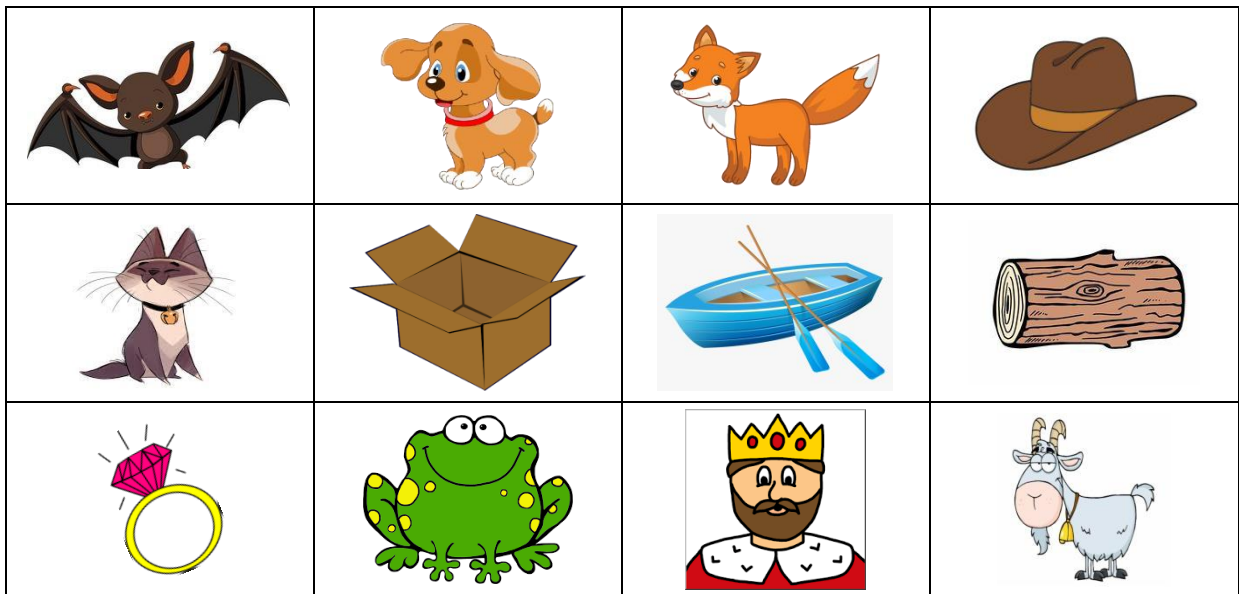
Introduction
