The castle cook has asked you to complete her challenges this week.

	Why are we doing this?	Activity
Monday	To practise researching and making notes.	Find some recipes for the cook to use in the banquet at the castle. Draw or write down your ideas.
Tuesday	To be able to use question marks when asking questions. Questions start with words like Why? When? How? Who?	Can you ask the cook questions about her job at the castle? What would you like to find out about what she does? Who she works for or how she feels about her job.
Wednesday	To be able to write a short description. Remember to include interesting adjectives and write in sentences.	The castle is looking for another cook and we want you to write a job description to find the best person. What do you think will encourage people to apply? What would the new cook have to do? What should a good cook be like?
Thursday	To be able to follow instructions.	Can you choose a simple recipe (from Medieval times) to cook at home? Can you follow the instructions carefully? What do your family think of what you made? Would you eat it again?
Friday	To be able to write a set of instructions. You will need to include: Bossy (imperative) verbs like mix, stir, put, bake. Write in numbered steps. Use time conjunctions like first, now, then, next, finally	Can you write down your recipe and send it to the cook? – either photograph and email or upload to Seesaw.
