

















The Serjeant-at-Arms' Challenge – week beginning 4th May

	Why are we doing this?	Activity	
  Monday	To be able to use question marks when asking questions	Can you ask the Serjeant-at-Arms questions about his job? What would you like to find out about being a knight? Who does he work for and what would you like to know about his job?	  
 Tuesday	To be able to choose the best words to grab your audience's attention and to use your phonics to spell.	There is going to be a Grand Tournament at the Castle. Can you make a poster to advertise it?	 
 Wednesday	To be able to write a recount about events that have happened (and to remember which tense to use).	Can you write or make a news report about the Knights' Tournament?	
  Thursday	To be able to create a character and to use adjectives to describe their appearance and personality.	Can you create a character that could be part of a story about a knight? Can you draw and describe what they look like? Can you describe their personality?	  
 Friday	To be able to write the resolution and ending for a story (Extension – to write your own story using the characters)	Can you use the knight character that you created yesterday to finish the story?
