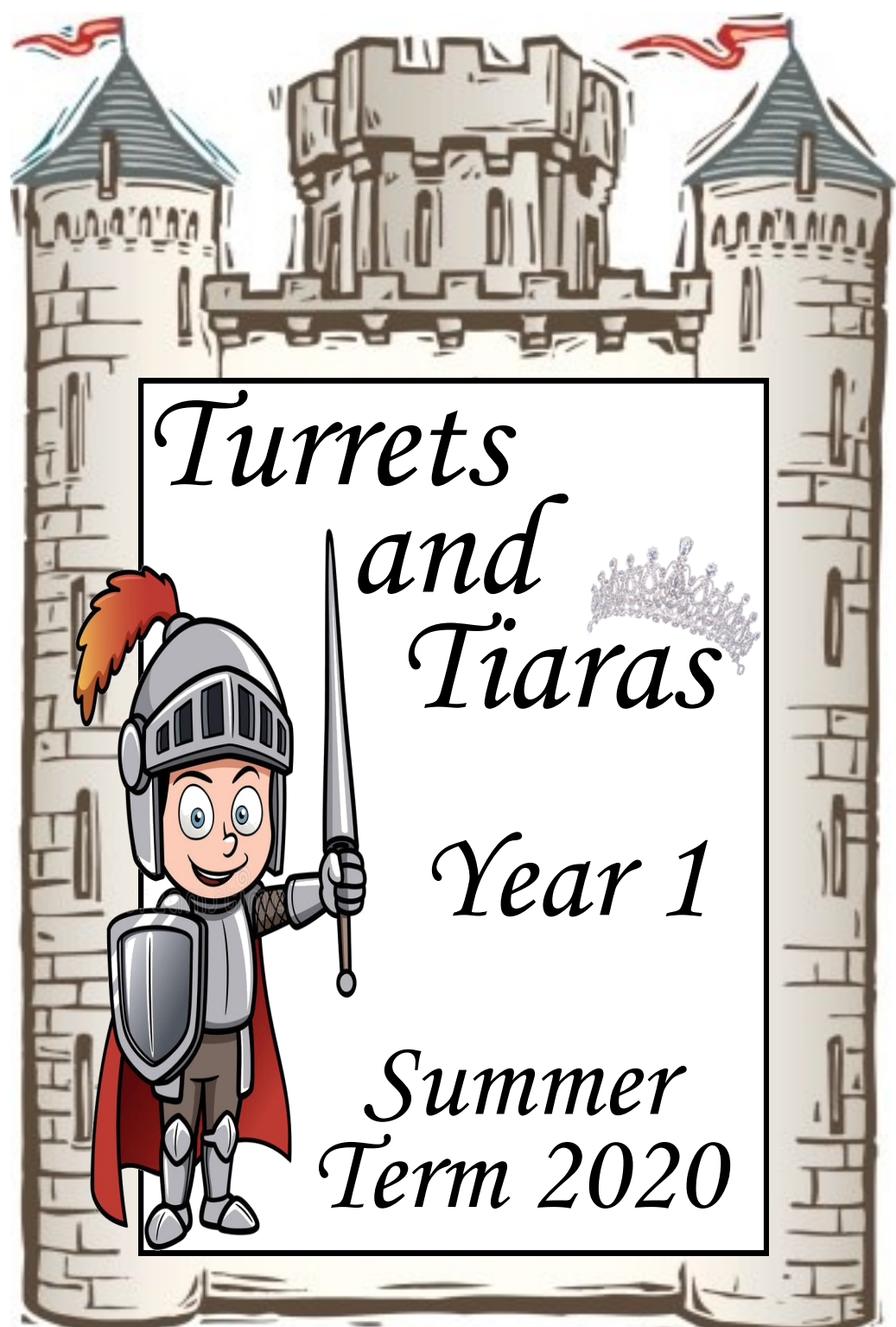
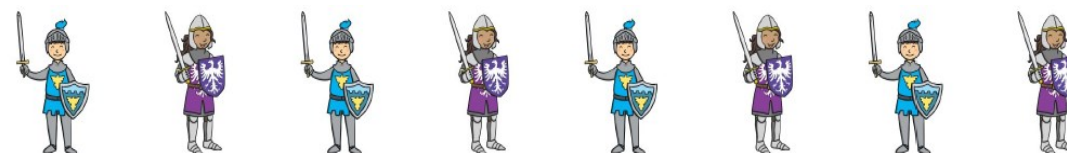
- * Why were castles built?

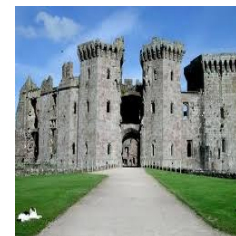
