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| Monday | Activity Play Flashcards: Time Challenge on Phonics Play. How many phonemes can you say in 1 minute? Try again: did you beat your score? Send your highest score to your teacher on Seesaw. |
| | Challenge Read a school reading book (either a real one or one on Bug Club). |
| Tuesday | Activity Play Space Race on Phonics Play. Can you get Bob to Obb's planet? If it's too easy – try a harder phase. |
| | Challenge Can you write 4 sentences with split digraphs? |
| Wednesday | Activity Play Cheeky Chimps on Phonics Play. Practise any grapheme you found hard earlier on and see how you get on. |
| | Challenge Read a book from home. Don't forget to use your phonics to help you sound out the hard words. |
| Thursday | Activity Play either Dragon's Den , Picnic on Pluto , or Buried Treasure on Phonics Play. Practise any digraphs or trigraphs that you have found difficult or Select Revise all Phase 5. |
| | Challenge Can you use your phonics to help you write your three favourite memories of Year 1? |
| Friday | Activity Play Sentence Substitution and see if you can make up any sentences. What's the silliest one you can make? |
| | Challenge Pick any digraph. How many words can you write with the same digraph? (e.g. <u>phonics</u> , <u>digraph</u> , <u>phone</u> ...) |
