Monday	Meet the Jester	Think of questions that you would like to ask the Jester so you can find out about life in the castle. Send them either through the website or to your teacher using Seesaw.	To write in sentences, using appropriate punctuation (Capital Letters and Full Stops or Question Marks).
Tuesday	Joke telling	Can you write your favourite joke?	To form letters neatly, starting and finishing in the correct place and taking care to present our writing neatly.
Wednesday	The Jester will answer your questions, and talk about his life in the castle.	Can you learn to juggle? Watch the videos and give it a try yourself. Then write down the instructions for someone else to try.	To write instructions in order. To use imperative (bossy) verbs.
Thursday	The Jester is learning a new song.	Can you learn a silly song or a poem and share it with the Jester?	To read accurately by blending sounds. To participate in performance. To appreciate rhymes and poems. To use my voice expressively to chant/sing.
Friday	The Jester's struggling to write a poem.	The King has asked the jester to write a poem for him. Can you help?	To listen to and discuss poems. To appreciate rhymes and poems. To compose and sequence sentences.
