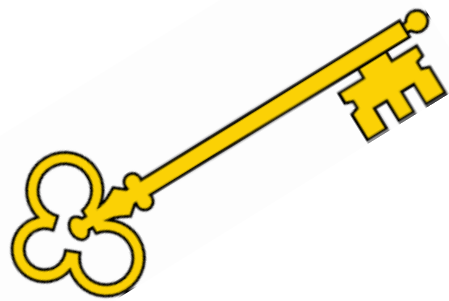

Text Type Features

→ Main character warned not to do something, does it anyway and gets into trouble.

Narrative Features:

→ **Introduction** - introduces characters and setting.

→ **Build Up** - what the characters are doing.

→ **Problem** - something that goes wrong.

→ **Resolution** - how the problem is solved

→ **Ending** - what the characters do at the end
