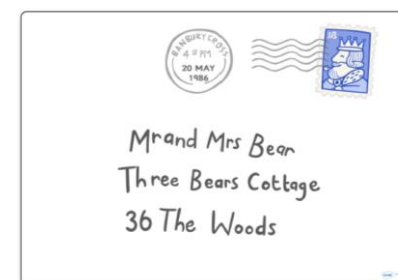

Text Type Features

- Letter features:
 - **Dear** - who the letter is for
 - **Purpose** - why the letter is being written
 - **From** - who has written the letter
- Persuasive Writing features:
 - **Opening sentence** - What the text is trying to persuade the reader to do.
 - **Positive points** - three positive things that will persuade the reader.
 - **Conclusion** - a summary of the points.
