Facts

- Holy week is very important for Christians as it is when they believe Jesus was crucified and raised from the dead.
- The story of Jesus's death tells Christians that there is life after death.
- Lots of celebrations happen for Christians during Holy week to remind them of Jesus and the sacrifices he made for them.
- Christians believe that Jesus was crucified, died and then rose from the dead (resurrected).
- Lots of symbolic gestures are made during Holy week, which link to Jesus's death - hot cross buns, the giving of eggs, the crosses made of palm leaves.
- Lots of people find it helpful to believe in life after death.
