- ← Funk-music with strong bass lines
- Pulse- the regular heartbeat of the music
- ➡ Rhythm- long and short sounds that happen over the pulse
- ← Pitch-high and low sounds
- Compose- create and develop music
- Here Improvise-to make up a tune and play it on the spot
- ← Perform singing and playing for others to hear
- ← Groove-the rhythmic part of music that makes you want to move and dance
- ← Keyboard- electric instrument played like a piano
- ► Bass Lowest part of the music
