Can he save her?



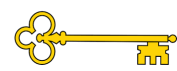

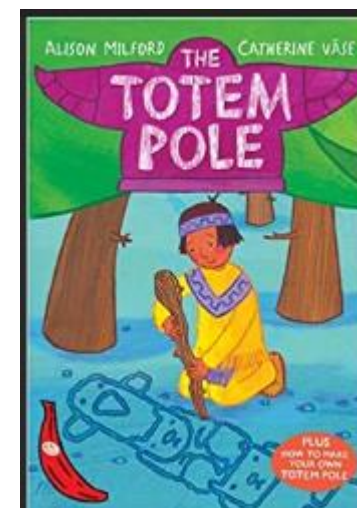
