Vocabulary

parable	A special story that Jesus told to help people understand about God
prayer	Talking to God
forgive	To stop feeling angry about something somebody has done and 'move on'
Bible	The holy book of the Christian faith.
praise	To talk (or sing) about how great something is (in this case, God).

Facts

- .Christians learn about God from the Bible
- Christians believe that Jesus told Parables to help them understand God.
- Forgiveness is very important to Christians.
- Praying is how Christians talk to God.
- There are four main types of prayer: praise, saying 'sorry', saying 'thank you' and asking for something.
- The parable of the Lost Son tells Christians about forgiveness and saying sorry.
