We are writing to let you know our arrangements for next week. We hope that they make sense and that we have answered as many questions as possible that you may have. We are very excited to have the school filled with all the children's voices and seeing everyone again on Monday.


## How will drop off work?

We will be opening the gates for drop off between 8.40am and 9.10am. Please do not come onto the school site until 8.40am at the earliest. A face covering MUST be worn at all times when you are on the school site, unless you have told us in the past that you have a legitimate reason for not wearing one. You are welcome to drop your child/children off at <u>any</u> time within this window. If you are able to drop off closer to 9am that would really help the staggering of arrivals to ensure we can all maintain social distancing guidelines on the drive and around the school site. If everybody arrives at 8.40am there will be a huge queue so if you are able to come slightly later that would help everybody. We do not know if the road closure will be in place on Highfield Road again.

All parents and children will follow the same one-way system that was in place before this lockdown.

- **Key Stage 1** will continue to leave through the library and exit the school via the office.
- **Key Stage 2** will drop off at the KS2 building then continue to walk past the building, through the Brooklands field gate and down the field back onto the carpark.
- **Reception** will drop off and then continue on the path passed the Reception building and through the gate to Brooklands field and down to the car park.
- **Little Learners** will drop off and then continue on the path past the end of the Reception building and go through the gate to Brooklands field and down to the car park.

Please take a look at the map below. We hope that it helps. There will of course be staff around the site to help too. Please do not walk against the one-way system. If you have children in different key stages then you only need to walk round once as children, in most cases, can be sent to class.





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### How will pick up work?

As with drop offs, we will be having a half hour window for collection from **3pm to 3.30pm**. We are asking you again to come at <u>any</u> time within this time. All parents and carers will follow the exact same route as the morning drop off above.

### **Lunches**

We will continue to publish our menu in the Leedon Link ready for the next week. Children will be asked to order their lunch choice when they register in the morning. A reminder that all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to Universal Free School Meals. For children who are not entitled to Free School Meals in Year 3 & 4 the cost is £2.20 per day.

If you're working circumstances have changed during the pandemic and you think your child may be entitled to Free School Meals you can find out more information at

All children who are having school dinners will be eating in the hall. Children who have a packed lunch will eat in the classrooms, at least for the first three weeks.

We understand that there may be some anxiety for you and your children in returning to school. Our afternoons this half term will be heavily focused on the children's wellbeing, spending time socialising with their friends and working on their independent learning skills. Our wonderful pastoral team will also be working with individual and small groups of children when needed.

Therefore, please make sure your child is appropriately dressed in an extra layer for warmth.

If your child has had a growth spurt since last year don't worry, any uniform that fits is fine in the short term and trainers are not a problem if you've seen their feet expand too!
