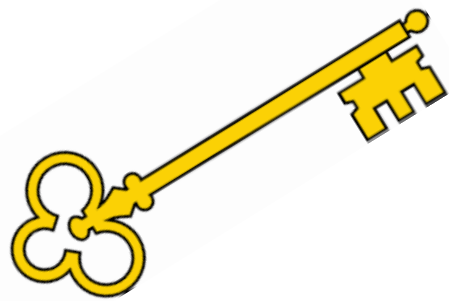

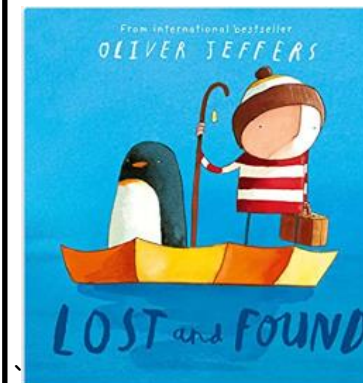
Text Type Features
