- Genesis 1 is the Jewish and Christian story of creation. It tells Jewish and Christian people that God is great, creative and concerned with creation.
- Khalifah in Islam means that humans have a responsibility to look after the earth and act as a 'steward'.
- Jewish people practise the idea of Tikkun Olam, which is repairing the world. They also have a celebration called Tu B'shevat, which is a new year celebration for trees.
- Christians celebrate harvest to thank God for the bounties he has had provided.
