

Listening & Appraising

- Know an increasing variety of songs by heart.

- To understand that songs/music can tell a story or describe an idea.

Singing & Playing Tuned & Un-tuned Instruments.

- To know that unison is everyone singing at the same time.
- To know that songs include other ways of using the voice eg rapping.
- To know why we need to warm up our voices.
- To know when to start and stop singing when following a leader.
- When playing instrumental parts, learn the names of notes in their part from memory or when written down.
- Know the names of tuned and un-tuned instruments played in class.
- Play instruments in time with a steady pulse.
- Listen to and follow musical instructions from a leader.

Improvise, Compose and Perform

- Improvise in different ways using one or two notes eg by clapping, singing, playing
- Create simple melodies using 1-5 notes.
- Know how the notes of compositions can be written down and changed if
- To identify pitch, duration, dynamics, tempo, timbre, structure and texture in music and respond to it via games, movements, singing and when playing instruments.
- Perform known songs adding their own ideas to the performance and respond to recordings of their performance expressing feelings about it.

audience spectators or listeners to a performance. an instrument or voice that is lowest in pitch. bass

a person who writes music. composer

a percussion instrument that is beaten drums

duration how long or short a note or section of music is.

the volume of a sound or note. dynamics

electric guitar a type of guitar.

improvise making up your own tunes on the spot. keyboard a set of keys on a piano or similar instrument. melody a combination of pitch and rhythm, a tune.

musician a person who plays a musical instrument, especially as a job.

notation symbols and notes which represent music.

a sentence to find out information

a type of music where words are spoken quickly and rhythmically. rap

a music genre that originated in Jamaica and usually relates news, social gossip and political ideas. reggae rhythm

a pattern of long and short sounds as you move through a song.

a type of music usually based around electric bass, drums and guitars. a metal wind instrument used especially in jazz and dance music. saxophone

structure different sections in music eg verse and chorus. the speed at which a piece of music is played. layers/combinations of sound in a composition.

different types of sound produced. timbre
