Qur'an	The holy book of the Muslim faith
Torah	The holy book of the Jewish faith.
synagogue	The building where Jewish people pray and worship
parable	A story that Christians believe Jesus told to teach about God

Facts

- Many religious stories have lessons in them about how to behave.
- The Bible is split into two parts – The Old Testament (from before Jesus was born) and the New Testament (from after).
- The Qur'an is traditionally written in Arabic.
- The Torah is written in Hebrew. It is written on a scroll.
- Torah's are written by hand.
- People show respect for the Qur'an by washing their hands before touching it and keeping it in a high place.
- Jewish people will use a special pointer to help them read the scroll so they don't touch it.
- Christians believe that Jesus told Parables to help them understand God.
