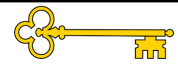

Spellings

- Creating adverbs by adding *ly* and not changing the root word
(kindly, quickly, safely, rudely, sweetly, strongly, bravely, secretly, finally, usually)
- Creating adverbs by adding *ly* when the root word ends in *y* and has more than one syllable
(happily, angrily, lazily, busily, easily, greedily, messily, wearily, cheekily, clumsily)
- Creating adverbs by adding *ly* when the root word ends in *le*. (gently, simply, humbly, nobly, horrible, terribly, possibly, incredibly comfortably, probably)

Text Type Features

- paragraphs
- opening, build-up, problem, resolution, ending
- someone gives the main characters a warning but they ignore it
- describe the dangerous setting
- the characters get into trouble as a result
- show don't tell how the characters are feeling
- a suspenseful rescue
- the characters are safe in the end but have to suffer the consequences of their actions and get told off.
