- Matthew 4:18-22 tells the story of when Jesus called his first disciples; Peter, Andrew, James and John. They left everything behind to follow Jesus.
- Mark 1:40-44 tells the story of when Jesus cured a leper, who was very ill and had been rejected by everyone else. Jesus touched him and cured him when everyone else had ignored him.
- Luke 10:25-37 tells the story of the Good Samaritan, who helped an injured enemy when all others had ignored him and left him to die.
- Christians try to live their lives in the way that Jesus would want. Church leaders help the community and show love for their 'neighbours'.
- Other religions also want the world to be a better place.
