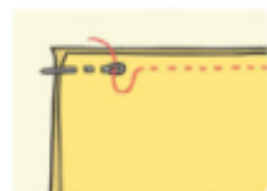

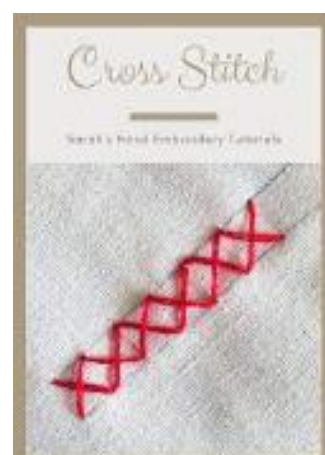

Vocabulary

textiles	Using fabric, thread, wool in design
reinforce	Ensuring something is secure
knotting	Tying the thread to make sure it doesn't become loose
looping	Type of stitch where the thread is sewn over and round
chain stitch	Stitch created by pushing needle up and through the middle of two threads
running stitch	Straight line stitch in and out
backstitch	A stitch that loops backwards to create an unbroken line
cross stitch	Stitching in a diagonal/crossed pattern



Skills

- Design** - Use research and develop design criteria to inform the design of innovative, functional, appealing products that are fit for purpose, aimed at particular individuals or groups
- Generate, develop, model and communicate their ideas through discussion, annotated sketches, cross-sectional and exploded diagrams, prototypes, pattern pieces and computer-aided design
- Make** Select from and use a wider range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks [for example, cutting, shaping, joining and finishing], accurately
- Select from and use a wider range of materials and components, including construction materials, textiles and ingredients, according to their functional properties and aesthetic qualities
- Evaluate** investigate and analyse a range of existing products
- Evaluate their ideas and products against their own design criteria and consider the views of others to improve their work
- Understand how key events and individuals in design and technology have helped shape the world
- Cut and shape materials** - scissors for cutting
 - Joining, knotting, looping, sewing - cross stitch, chain stitch, running stitch and backstitch
