Spellings

- words with a shuhn sound, spelt with 'sion' (If root word ends in 'se', 'de', or 'd') (expansion, extension, comprehension, tension, corrosion, supervision, fusion, conclusion, persuasion, suspension)
- words with a shuhm sound, spelt with 'sion' (if root word ends in 'ss' or 'mit') (expression, discussion, confession, permission, admission, transmission, possession, profession, depression, impression)
- words ending with shuhn sound spelt 'tion' If root word ends in 'te' or 't' or has no definite root. (invention, injection, action, question, mention, attraction, translation, devotion, position, solution)



