Spellings

- Adding the prefix inter – (Meaning 'between' or 'among') interact, interfere, intercity, international, intermediate, internet, intergalactic, interrupt, intervene, interlude.
- Adding the prefix anti- (meaning 'against') anticlockwise, antiseptic, antisocial, antidote, antibiotic, antivenom, anti-ageing, antifreeze, antiperspirant, antigravity
- Adding the prefix auto- (meaning 'self' or 'own') autograph, autobiography, automatic, autofocus, autocorrect, autopilot, autorotate, automobile, autonomy, autocue
- Adding the prefix ex- (meaning 'out') exit, extend, explode, excursion, exchange, export, exclaim, expel, external, exterior
- Adding the prefix non- (meaning 'not') non-stick, non-stop, non-starter, non-smoker, nonsense, non-fiction, non-drip, non-violent, non-profit, non-believer
- Words ending in -ar/-er. Calendar, grammar, regular, particular, peculiar, popular, consider, remember, quarter, integer

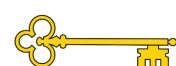
