- Words with /aw/ spelt with 'augh' and 'au' (caught, naughty, taught, daughter, autumn, clause, cause, astronaut, applaud, author)
- Adding the prefix **in-**, meaning 'not' or 'into' (inactive, incorrect, inaccurate, insecure, indefinite, incomplete, infinite, inedible, inability, indecisive)
- adding prefix **im-**, before a root word starting with **m** or **p**. (immature, immeasurable, impossible, immortal, imperfect, impatient, immovable, impolite, important, improper)
