Facts

- Christians believe that Jesus was resurrected to new life to bring in a new kingdom where God rules in people's lives.
- Acts 2:1-15, 22 and 37-41 tells the story of The Pentecost. After Jesus ascended into Heaven, the disciples continued to meet and pray. One day flames appeared above their heads and they had received the Holy Spirit.
- Pentecost is celebrated 50 days after Easter Sunday and is thought of as the birthday of the church.
- Christians believe that they receive the Holy Spirit when they accept Christ and become Christians. They believe that the Holy Spirit never leaves them and therefore, God never leaves them.
- During Pentecost, red is used in the church and often, the ministers will wear red. The symbol of the flames that appeared above the disciples' heads will also be seen.
